- Newsletter: Encourage ALL clubs to submit stories, activities, and upcoming events, most importantly their successes to the monthly newsletter to share what they are doing and help inspire other clubs by their example
- Promote the Lions CUB Program and Families as a way of attracting new members

Governor's contest 2013-2014

1. Earn 10 points for retention of your current club membership as of July 2013 MMR.
2. Earn 10 points for each new member since that July 2013 MMR total.
3. Activity reports: Earn up to 30 points for submitting 3 on time activity reports.
4. Earn 15 points for each story that gets published in the Newspaper or airs on TV about your Club or one of its members.
5. Earn 20 points if your club has or if it creates a Facebook page.
6. Earn 20 points for submitting your new officers PU101 to LCI by May 15, 2014.
7. Earn 40 points: Hold a CEP (Club Excellence Process) meeting coordinated through your District GLT representative PDG Richard Perrin.

“NEW” Visitor Registry Contest (Non-Lions visitors 18 or older)

This year each club will be given a Visitor Log Book. What we're asking is for your club members to try to bring in as many as possible non-lion visitors age 18 or older to a **normal club meeting** with the idea being the more people we expose to Lions and what we do, the better chance we will have of gaining new members.

A **second contest** will be which club has the best looking

book by the end of the year so feel free to decorate your book, personalize it to your club!

Bonus points go to visitors brought in who are at least 5 years younger than the Lion bringing them. Please mark their names with a check mark.

Limit 1 entry per visitor. Speakers and or entertainment are not eligible.

The winning club will be determined based on percentage of club members to visitors so ALL clubs have an even chance of winning.

Awards:

A “**Membership Award**” plaque will be awarded to the club with the highest yearly membership growth, based on July 2013 starting figures.

Note: Club secretaries are responsible for submitting qualifying information either on a monthly basis or by the end of June, 2014.

A “**Visitation Award**” plaque will be awarded to the club with the most Non-Lion 1st time visitors to attend a normal club meeting age 18 or over based on membership percentages. Each new visitor is a potential “New” member! (Registry Book)

Note: Please remember a visitor can only be counted once in the 2013-2014 Lion’s year

District Governor's Official Visit

The District Governor or a Vice Governor is required to make an official visit to each club during the year. With 46 clubs to visit, not counting special events, meetings and Conventions, the Governor's and Vice-Governors' schedules are quite busy. The following suggestions will help your club make the Governor's visit a pleasurable and productive one.

1. Plan early for Governor's visit. Contact the Governor to confirm as early in the year as possible.
2. Choose a date that is likely to have high attendance such as Club Charter Night or Anniversary.
3. Your request for a visit should include all pertinent information such as date, time, location, and if a meal will be served.
4. No other speakers or programs, other than abbreviated business meetings, should be scheduled for this evening.
5. Make sure greeters are available to make the Governor welcome. If the club has particular concerns or issues it would like the Governor to address they should be addressed in the invitation or by the greeter.
6. Prepare a suitable introduction for the governor. If your Club has a past International Officer or Past District Governor, he or she might introduce the Governor.
7. All members should rise when the Governor is officially introduced and when he has concluded his comments.
8. Many clubs present the visiting Governor with a small gift as a token of respect and appreciation for the time and effort in fulfillment of his duties. A donation to one of the State projects in the Governors name is a particularly meaningful gift.
9. Let the Governor know in advance if you want him to induct new members, club officers or present special awards.
10. Please publicize the Governors visit in your local newspaper.

Melvin Jones Fellowship

The Melvin Jones Fellowship (MJF) recognizes donations of US\$1,000. It is the backbone of LCIF, providing 75 percent of the foundation's revenue. As recognition of humanitarian work, an MJF is an honor presented to those who donate US\$1,000 to LCIF or to people for whom a donation was made by others.

Contributions can be made by individuals (including non-Lions), clubs or districts. Donations may be in one sum, or in installments of a minimum of US\$100 over a five-year period. Melvin Jones Fellows receive an attractive lapel pin, a plaque and a congratulatory letter.

Progressive Melvin Jones Fellowships

The Progressive Melvin Jones Fellowship (PMJF) program is a way for donors to extend their commitment to LCIF. There are 100 recognition levels, one for each US\$1,000 donation beyond the initial US\$1,000 MJF contribution. For each US\$1,000 contribution, there is a unique pin. After contributing US\$100,000, donors become Humanitarian Partners.

The Fellowship was established in 1973 and the Progressive program began in 1986 in response to Lions' request for a way to extend their commitment to LCIF. Donations through MJFs provide 75 percent of the Foundation's annual revenue.

Most of the funds raised during Campaign SightFirst and Campaign SightFirst II were through MJF donations.

As of the end of December 2011, there are 331,684 MJFs and 61,493 PMJFs worldwide.

The names of MJFs are displayed on a computer in the LCIF Room at the International Headquarters.

- Outstanding humanitarian achievement- not necessarily directly related to Lionism.



John S. Noel Fellow

The John S. Noel Fellow is the Lions of Michigan Foundation's most distinguished form of recognition, and the award is available to recognize an outstanding individual for his or her service to Lions and those in need. The award is available for contributions of \$1,000 or more to the Lions of Michigan Foundation.

John S. Noel was a charter member of the Grand Rapids Lions Club in 1919, and he was Michigan's 1st President of Lions Clubs International in 1923-24. The award is duly named in honor of John S. Noel's accomplishments in advancing the cause of Lionism in Michigan and throughout the world and for his tireless efforts to help people in need



Ken E. Lautzenheiser Fellow

Ken E. Lautzenheiser served Lions for over 45 years, and he was a charter member of the Inter-lakes Lions Club. Ken was elected to the Board of Lions Clubs International in 1985, and over his lifetime he served Lions in almost every capacity.

Ken E. Lautzenheiser was instrumental in organizing the Lions of Michigan Foundation in the early 1980's. He believed there was a definite need in Michigan for an organization that could address the medical needs of individuals that had no insurance and nowhere else to turn. Ken knew that if Lions Clubs combined resources, Lions could have a greater impact on their communities and do more to help people in need.

The Ken E. Lautzenheiser Fellow is available for contributions of \$500 or more to the Lions of Michigan Foundation and is often used to recognize extraordinary efforts by a Lion or Lioness Club member - many Clubs and Districts use the award to recognize the Lion and/or Lioness of the year.
